- **CONNECTIONS** are created when a person with blindness or visual impairments hears about MARRS, gets a radio or listens online, and feels supported by the service.
- **CONNECTIONS** are created when someone listens to the MARRS broadcast and hears local news and talks about our community with family and friends.
- **CONNECTIONS** are created when a patient at Mission Health or the Charles George VA Hospital listens to the MARRS broadcast and knows what is happening in our local community outside the hospital room.
- **CONNECTIONS** are created when a volunteer reader comes to the Vanderbilt Apartments and, along with a friend, reads the local newspaper for the MARRS broadcast.
